Organizational Profile

Date Founded: Hunt Regional Healthcare was adopted as the operating name for the Hunt Memorial Hospital District on September 25, 2008 by action of the HMHD Board of Directors. The new operating name is effective October 1, 2008. This nomenclature represents a logical next step in the organization's evolution into a comprehensive, regional healthcare system. The organization became a county-wide hospital district on November 3, 1981.

Purpose: Hunt Regional Healthcare is an organization comprised of two hospitals and several other operating units. The nomenclature "Hunt Regional Healthcare" is the umbrella public operating name of the organization and will be used in all public communication, marketing and advertising applications. The statutory name, "Hunt Memorial Hospital District," is retained as the identifying name for the Board of Directors and for legal and fiscal applications.

Other Operating Unit Names: The following are the new operating names for other entities within the organization and become effective October 1, 2008:

- **Hunt Regional Medical Center** – to reflect the regional services provided and patients treated at our Greenville acute care hospital, formerly called Presbyterian Hospital of Greenville;
- **Hunt Regional Community Hospital** – to reflect the community focus and medical services provided at our Commerce critical access hospital, formerly called Presbyterian Hospital of Commerce;
- **Hunt Regional Home Care** – to reflect the regional coverage of our home nursing and therapy services, formerly called Citizens Home Health;

- **Hunt Regional Occupational Health** – to reflect our expanding role in meeting the healthcare needs of area industry, formerly Presbyterian Occupational Health Network.
- **Hunt Regional Emergency Services** – to reflect the border-to-border Emergency Management Services provided by the ambulance and first responder groups within our Hunt community;
- **Hunt Regional Medical Plaza** – to reflect the primary care and radiology services provided at our facility located in Quinlan, previously called Presbyterian Medical Plaza;
- **Hunt Regional Minor Care Clinic** – to reflect the non-emergent medical care provided in our new clinic located in South Greenville in the Traders Crossing Shopping Center at 8110 Wesley St.
