

NEW NAMES ADOPTED FOR HMHD OPERATING UNITS

In action taken on September 25, 2008, the Board of Directors of the Hunt Memorial Hospital District formally adopted the following names for its operating units:

- **Hunt Regional Healthcare** – this will serve as the umbrella operating (d.b.a.) name for the organization and will be used in all public marketing and related applications. The statutory name “Hunt Memorial Hospital District” will be reserved for identifying the Board of Directors and in specific legal and financial applications.
- **Hunt Regional Medical Center** – to reflect the regional services provided and patients treated at our Greenville hospital, formerly called Presbyterian Hospital of Greenville;
- **Hunt Regional Community Hospital** – to reflect the community focus and medical services provided at our Commerce hospital, formerly called Presbyterian Hospital of Commerce;
- **Hunt Regional Home Care** – to reflect the regional coverage of our home nursing and therapy services, formerly called Citizens Home Health;
- **Hunt Regional Occupational Health** – to reflect our expanding role in meeting the healthcare needs of area industry, formerly Presbyterian Occupational Health Network;
- **Hunt Regional Emergency Services** – to reflect the border-to-border Emergency Management Services provided by the ambulance and first responder groups within our Hunt community;
- **Hunt Regional Medical Plaza** – to reflect the primary care and radiology services provided at our facility located in Quinlan, previously called Presbyterian Medical Plaza;
- **Hunt Regional Minor Care Clinic** – to reflect the non-emergent medical care provided in our new clinic located in South Greenville in the Traders Crossing Shopping Center at 8110 Wesley St.
